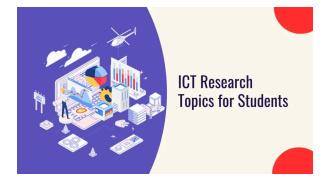
Doing research helps students learn important skills like finding information, working with numbers, and sharing their findings. These skills are important for school and future jobs.
